Parade Date: Saturday, October 28, 2023, Application Deadline: October 20, 2023

Entries received after deadline may be placed at the end of the parade and not judged.

No entry may throw candy, gum, toys, pamphlets, or campaign materials from any vehicle.

These items <u>may be handed out</u> by people walking along the parade route. Suggested distance between entries is three car lengths. Keep parade moving slowly and smoothly. <u>DO NOT STOP</u> <u>TO PERFORM. Observe</u> all traffic safety regulations. <u>WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO ANY APPLICATION.</u>

PARADE LINE-UP

Parade lines up on Old Highway 56. Line-up will be on the highway. Buses and vehicles may unload at this site and then drive to Civic Center on corner of 1st and Mekusukey and park in Civic Center parking lot. Parade check in will be at parade line up on Old Highway 56.
